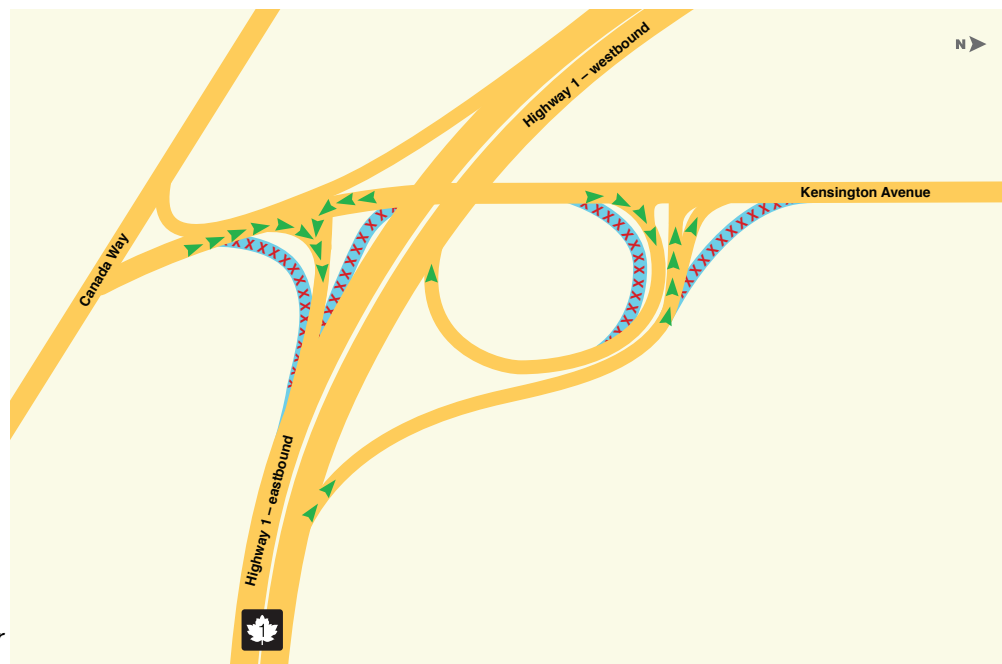
### Notice of Lane Changes — Kensington Avenue to/from Highway 1

As part of the Port Mann/Highway 1 Improvement (PMH1) Project, work is underway on the Highway 1/Kensington Avenue Interchange in Burnaby. In order to upgrade this interchange, there will be some changes to traffic flow from Kensington Avenue to/from Highway 1. These changes will be in effect **starting the week of January 4, 2010** and will continue through 2011. (*please note*: dates are subject to change due to weather conditions)

Motorists travelling northbound or southbound on Kensington Avenue wishing to access Highway 1 **eastbound** will use a single newly-built ramp between the existing on-ramp lanes. There will no longer be two separate on-ramps for eastbound traffic. Traffic changes for Kensington Avenue northbound traffic wishing to access Highway 1 **westbound** are similar. These changes are illustrated in the map below, where the green arrows show the new traffic patterns.

On Kensington Avenue there will be 'turning only' lanes and 'through traffic' lanes. New road signs and markings will highlight these changes.

These temporary traffic pattern changes will create room for crews to construct a new, wider interchange. The new Kensington Avenue structure will accommodate four lanes between Canada Way and Spratt Street, with left-hand turn access to Thomas Street. It will include a multi-use path on the west side. Safety will be improved for vehicles, pedestrians and cyclists.
