Temporary Lane Closures on Broadway at Highway 1

As part of the Port Mann/Highway 1 Improvement (PMH1) Project, travellers are advised that starting on **January 19th, there will be four nights of lane shifts and lane closures** between the hours of 11 p.m. and 5 a.m., on Broadway/Lougheed Highway underneath Highway 1. These closures are needed to install girders (steel beams) that will support the improved overpass structure and to place pre-cast panels for the new bridge deck that will support the addition of one highway lane in each direction at this location.

The closures will intermittently affect lanes in both eastbound and westbound directions over the four night period. Travellers are reminded to exercise caution at all times and obey construction signs and traffic cones. Drivers may wish to use alternate routes during this period.

Every effort will be made to minimize delays to the travelling public. These changes will be well signed and traffic control personnel and equipment will be on site to direct traffic. Please exercise caution and obey flaggers.

A key goal of the PMH1 project is to maximize predictability during construction and minimize disruption for commuters, goods movers, residents and the public. Construction updates will be issued regularly as the project progresses.
