

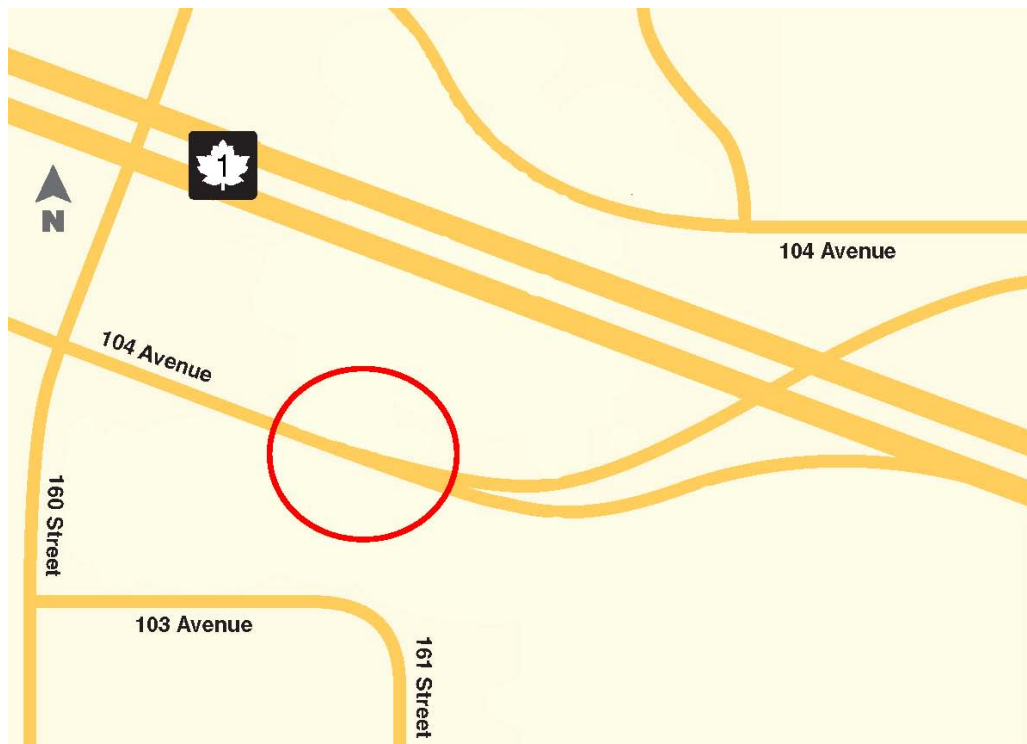
CONSTRUCTION BULLETIN

Notice of Road Maintenance Work on 104 Avenue at the 160 Street Interchange in Surrey

Travellers are advised that on **Friday, March 26**, roadwork will occur from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. on 104 Avenue, to the east of the 104 Avenue/160 Street intersection (see red circle). This work is required for road maintenance.

To complete this work, single lane alternating traffic on 104 Avenue will be required. Traffic control personnel will be in place at all times to manage traffic flow.

Signs will be in place to notify travellers of the work and traffic control personnel will be on site to direct traffic during this period. Drivers are reminded to obey posted construction speeds and watch for flag persons.



A key goal of the PMH1 project is to maximize predictability during construction and minimize disruption for commuters, goods movers, residents and the public.
