Traffic Pattern Change at Gaglardi Interchange westbound on-ramp

Improvements to the Gaglardi Way Interchange continue with changes to the Highway 1 westbound on-ramp. Starting April 23, 2010, motorists accessing Highway 1 westbound from Gaglardi Way will use **two new traffic signals**. (*please note: dates are subject to change due to weather conditions*)

This traffic pattern change is required for crews to safely build the new westbound on and off-ramps and for the construction of the new overpass structure. This change will be in place for the balance of construction.

What to Expect

- Motorists travelling southbound on Gaglardi Way accessing Highway 1 westbound will make a left-hand turn at a new signalized intersection.
- To help with traffic flow in this area, there will be a new signal on Gaglardi Way at Cariboo Road.
- The existing westbound on-ramp will be closed to traffic.

This new traffic pattern is illustrated on the diagram.

All changes will be well signed. Please exercise caution and watch for and obey the new signals in this area.
