Notice of Upcoming Cycling and Pedestrian Path detour: Boundary Road underneath Highway 1

As part of the Port Mann/Highway 1 Improvement (PMH1) Project, a new overpass will be constructed to take Highway 1 traffic over the BNSF Railway. This work will require a temporary detour for a small section of the Central Valley Greenway Multi-Use path that runs through the area. This detour will take effect during the week commencing April 19, 2010.

The temporary detour will occur just west of Boundary Road and will be in place until further notice. This change will allow for construction of new retaining walls to support the new structure, as well as demolition of the existing columns. The temporary path will be situated slightly to the south of the existing path and will be 3.5 m wide. The detour path will be paved and well-signed.

A key goal of the PMH1 project is to maximize predictability during construction and minimize disruption for commuters, goods movers, residents and the public. Construction updates will be issued regularly as the project progresses.
