

CONSTRUCTION BULLETIN

Bicycle Path Detour—Maquabeak Park, Coquitlam

Please be advised that the bicycle path that goes under the Port Mann Bridge, connecting Maquabeak Park to Colony Farm Regional Park, is temporarily closed. An alternative bicycle and pedestrian detour path is in place. This temporary detour is required for public safety during construction.

The detour route includes a combination of gravel paths and roadside shoulders and is well signed. Detour users are requested to respect adjacent private properties, use caution and watch for construction and other traffic.

When construction in the area is complete, the bicycle and pedestrian path will re-open under the Bridge.



A key goal of the PMH1 project is to maximize predictability during construction and minimize disruption for commuters, goods movers, residents and the public.
