Temporary Traffic Pattern Change on 176 Street in Surrey

Motorists and residents are advised that beginning on Friday, June 25, and continuing on Monday, June 28 and Tuesday, June 29, there will be single lane alternating traffic managed by flag personnel on 176 Street, approximately 200 metres south of 104 Avenue, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. This traffic pattern change is required for public safety as crews work to clear areas on the east side of 176 Street for the new intersection with the South Fraser Perimeter Road and 104 Avenue/176 Street.

Traffic control personnel will be on site to direct traffic during the single lane alternating period. Drivers are reminded to obey posted construction speeds and watch for both information signs and flag personnel.

A key goal of the PMH1 project is to maximize predictability during construction and minimize disruption for commuters, goods movers, residents and the public. Construction updates will be issued regularly as the project progresses.
