

## CONSTRUCTION BULLETIN

### Highway 1 Lane Shift - Highway 1 Between Cariboo Road and Brunette Avenue

Travellers are advised that beginning **July 16, 2010**, Highway 1 both eastbound and westbound between Cariboo Road and Brunette Avenue will be shifted to create more space for crews to begin construction on the additional lanes through this section of Highway 1. This shift will take several nights to implement, and will be in place until mid-2011. (*please note*: dates are subject to change due to weather)

Once this lane shift is complete, travel lanes and the median shoulder will be slightly narrowed. The outside shoulder will remain at the standard width, allowing emergency access when needed.

Drivers are requested to obey posted construction speeds and watch for construction information signs and flag persons, particularly at night, when intermittent lane closures may be required. As a reminder, traffic fines are double in construction zones.

*A key goal of the PMH1 project is to maximize predictability during construction and minimize disruption for commuters, goods movers, residents and the public. Construction updates will be issued regularly as the project progresses.
