15 Minute Closures on 1st Avenue at Highway 1

As part of the Port Mann/Highway 1 Improvement (PMH1) Project, motorists are advised that on **December 14th, 15th and 16th**, between the hours of 11 p.m. and 5 a.m., 1st Avenue will be closed intermittently at Highway 1. These closures are needed to install girders (concrete beams) that will support the improved overpass structure at this location.

The temporary closures will last for up to 15 minutes. Drivers may wish to use alternate routes during this period.

Every effort will be made to minimize delays to the travelling public. These changes will be well signed and traffic control personnel and equipment will be on site to direct traffic. Please exercise caution and obey flaggers.

A key goal of the PMH1 project is to maximize predictability during construction and minimize disruption for commuters, goods movers, residents and the public. Construction updates will be issued regularly as the project progresses.
